Tip of the Month:

Round over the tips of calipers. Calipers can be purchased inexpensively at garage sales and flea markets; however, they usually have been used for metal working so they have pointed or square tips. These tips will catch on the wood and cause the caliper to be thrown across the shop. Grind the inside of the tips to a smooth round finish and always be very careful when using calipers to measure diameters when the lathe is running.
